## Dr. William Bass at Sandusky

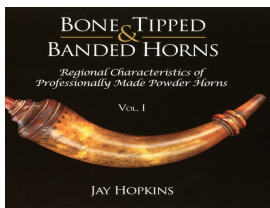
On October 17, Historic Sandusky was honored by a visit from acclaimed forensic scientist and archaeologist Dr. William Bass. Dr. Bass is better known as the "Bone Detective" and founder of the University of Tennessee's Anthropology Research Facility, aka "The Body Farm." While at Sandusky Dr. Bass spoke to Sandusky's Lynchburg College interns and graduate assistants.
