### The Visitor Center at Historic Sandusky is getting a new roof!

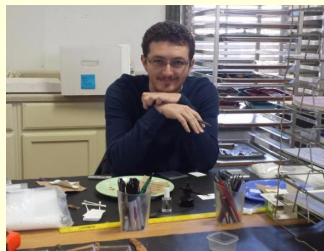
