### Historic Sandusky Projects

In one of Lynchburg College's Westover Honors classes, students are getting the opportunity to experience the lives of the "Common Soldiers of the Civil War."

The project came about when the Greater Lynchburg Community Trust awarded a \$4,000 grant to Historic Sandusky to help digitize the organization's library of historical documents. "History class is usually about reading a book and discussion of history, not handling material from the time period," said Lynchburg College History professor Dr. Adam Dean. "But these students have the opportunity to do the work of historians."
